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Minutes of Langcliffe Parish Council meeting held on the Zoom platform on Monday 5th October 2020 at 7.30pm.

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Councillors present – G. Cross (Chairman), H. Jarvis, B. Fiorato, I. Johnson, B. Croft, J. Sugden, J. Bagnall, D. Staveley, A. Blackburn (Clerk). Public present – none.

68/20. Apologies for Absence – W. Hull, R. Welch.

70/20. Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on the 7th September 2020 - Approved.

71/20. Matters Arising – Actions

Ref:47/20 – The Clerk informed Council that the Langcliffe Parish sign had now been installed near Barrel Sykes.

50/20 – The new bench donated by residents near Mount Pleasant had now been installed.

54/20 – A reply had been received from NY Highways stating that they would not be pruning the overgrowing tree at Locks Barn.

66/20 – The Clerk had not received notification from the property owners at Middle Fold in relation to sign relocation, Cllrs to liaise with owners.

73/20. Car Park & Parking issues.

Council discussed parking problems, Cllr Bagnall suggesting a consultation, this was considered. Council resolved to approve the removal of the garden area with a quotation received of £350-400. Expansion of the car park deferred.

Cllr Jarvis informed Council of the situation regarding equipment funding, requests had been submitted and replies had not been received as yet, the Covid 19 situation affecting response. Cllr Staveley suggesting Council contact CDC in relation to sports development funding. **Action** – Cllr Jarvis & Bagnall to continue sourcing play equipment & funding.

The updated plan was reviewed by Council and formally approved.

The Langcliffe Quarry planning application approval was discussed by Council. Cllr Staveley informing Council of the planning committee approval.

Council discussed the work that had been completed around the village area by volunteers, this including the maintenance of benches & railings, grass strimming & tree maintenance and also auditing of Council records and car park donation box collections, production of news letters, also residents who have provided help to their neighbours during these difficult times. Council expressed gratitude to all volunteers who have freely given their time for the benefit of the community.
