Daffodil bulbs now planted as an improvement measure at the lay-by.

Council discussed the on-going problems with Cement/dirt contamination on the B6479.

Large rubble pile at the side of the road. Environmental Health on-going assessment.

No planning application received by National Park re- large shed planned for the site.

R. Welch expressed concern as to the enforcement conditions not being addressed.

389/19. Land issues – Stocks Tree Area adjacent to gable wall – identified as a waste bin presentation area by CDC, in order to prevent damage to the Stocks Tree Kerb Edge & Buxton Place Lane.

Car Park Area – as in 387/19 above.

Strip of Land (Land Registry) – rejection letter received, advice given to re-submit.

Action – Clerk to re-submit.

390/19 – Planning Applications.

Planning application 2019/20215/FUL – Bowerley ECO House was discussed by Council.

Issues raised in relation to the visual aspect from the railway line – D. Staveley informed Council as to concerns.

Council resolved to approve the planning application.

Action – Clerk to submit decision to Craven District Council Planning.

391/19. Correspondence

Clerk informed Council of the complaint/ concerns expressed by a resident relating to the inconvenience of no land line whilst the new telegraph post was being replaced at Elwood Cottages, and the subsequent lack of telephone line following the work.

Council expressed its concern regarding the work, and the lack of notice given to residents.

Action – Clerk to complain to primary company involved, regarding absence of work notice.

Request from Highways for confirmation of grass cutting by the Parish Council for 2019-20.

Council confirmed its intention to cut the grass as defined by Highways.

Action – Clerk to liaise with Highways.

Request by residents of West View for Council to discuss plans for the replacement of railings and gates to the original items that were removed as part of the war effort.

Council commended the residents in their efforts in attracting up to 75% in grant funding for the project, and wishing them success in this venture. Council may contact the residents with recommendations for manufacturers/ contractors.

Request for assistance in housing historical long boards, previously housed at Langcliffe Hall
Council recommended contacting the Folly for the use/storage of the boards.
